There are many types of skills, students can develop skills through extracurricular activities, their academic coursework, a part-time job, job shadowing or internship, or even volunteer work. One important skill everyone needs is communication skills. Having good communication skill helps to communicate information effectively, clearly and accurately. It also includes being a good listener and helps to improve body language, tone of voice, facial expression, gestures etc. good communication skills able to deliver dynamic presentations persuade people to take an action or accept an opinion; write clear and effective e-mails and reports.
