Report of “Dr. Shankarraoji Chavan Competitive Examination Guidance Cell - 2019-20”.

Formation and effective implementation of this cell is one of the important parts of inclusive student centric policy of the college. The prime objective of the career guidance cell is to provide career oriented and supportive guidance to the college students and make aware about various career opportunities available for them. This cell also works in view to make available proper guidance of most successful and eminent personalities from different sectors and varied backgrounds. In this regard career guidance cell of the college invited diverse guests from Police Department, Administration, Education, Management field and Social background to inspire students towards competitive examinations as well as to make students capable to join these different sectors. As a result of these fruitful efforts of the college and healthy environment about competitive examinations enabled to produce considerable successful alumni.

In academic year 2019-20 career guidance cell of the college organised major four career guidance programs for students to enhance their enrichment in better career options than traditional one.

First, career guidance program was organised on 16th August 2019 to guide to students on “How to prepare for NET, GATE , JAM and other examination in science subjects ”. for this career counseling session Mr.

Jadhav Vijay Prabhakarrrao (Director , Vision Institute , Nanded) and Mr. Sangle Shrikant Ashokrao (Director Shrisha Science Academy, Nanded) were invited . Mr. Mr. Jadhav Vijay conducted first session, in his address he said that students must try for career opportunities rather than traditional one. Students must focus on new horizon in science which provides you abundant ways of prestigious career i.e. IIT – JAM, TIFR-NCBS Mumbai & Bangalore, CSIR- NET- JRF, ICMR-JRF, DBT-JRF, SET exam, GATE Exam, CUCET exam, GRE exam, reputed university entrance exam for higher studies etc. Mr. Sangle conducted second session and he explained in detail about structure of these various examinations and its marking scheme. He also told about how to study and which reference books should be used for the preparation. About 480 students got benefited by this career guidance session.

Second, career guidance program was organised on 27thAugust 2019 to guide studentson "**Career Opportunities in Banking Sector**". For this purpose college invited **Dr. Pate Shivaji**, Head, Department of Economics, Sant TukaramCollege, Parbhani.

Dr. Pate told that in his speech, students have wide career opportunities in banking sector as far as geographical wide area of our nation is concern.

Many co-operative, private, nationalized and foreign banks and their many branches are spread over the country. These all kind of banks and their lakhs of bank branches required crores of manpower for well functioning of Bank. Therefore, crores of banking vacancies are awaiting for skilled graduate students of any discipline and they can apply for the post of clerkship to officer grade in any banks. Students need to prepare for such banking exams (like IBPS, PO, IBPS various grade in various banks like RRB, SBI , RBI , NABARD and other banks) to get placed in one of the reputed banks of the country every year. These all banking exams are conducted at National level throughout the year. Candidates who aspire for banking career must be aware about all the banking exams and start preparing. Bank have very defined exam scheduled. Aspirants who want to end their struggle soon and get respected government job, they opt for banking jobs. Aspirants must update themselves about eligibility criteria, previous year cut offs, exam pattern, syllabus, marking scheme and time to time changes therein. Co-ordinator of guidance cell Dr. Muthe given an introduction about arrangement of this program, Vice Principal Dr. U. S. Sawant welcomed the guest Dr. Pate by offering bouquet. In this regard he told that, however what to read is important but what not to read is more important than this. Further he told that one can get success through proper study plan.
