In this regard career guidance cell of the college invited diverse guests from Police Department, Administration, Education, Management field and Social background to inspire students towards competitive examinations as well as to make students capable to join these different sectors. In addition to this Career Guidance Cell also had been active to provide online career guidance to the students due to COVID -19 pandemic situations during the academic year 2020-21. Guidance opportunities are provided throughout the year under the innovative online career guidance scheme run by the Maharashtra Government named "Career Katta". As a result of these fruitful efforts of the college and healthy environment about competitive examinations enabled to produce considerable successful alumni in various sectors.

In academic year 2020-21 career guidance cell of the college organized variousonlinecareer guidance programs though the COVID-19 Pandemic situation for students to enhance their enrichment in better career options than traditional one.

First, career Guidance program as Induction program was conducted entitled "Career Opportunities in Economics" on 5th Jan 2021at Cisco Webex Online platform college own subscription. On this occasion Dr. Subhash Kombde, Associate Professor,

Department of Economics, Shivaji University, Kolhapur was invited as chief guest and Dr. G. N. Shinde was Presided over the program.



Dr. Muthe P. R. Head of the department, given introduction about the aim of the program, historical perspective of the Economics Department, bright alumni, qualified staff, courses provided by the department etc. principal Dr. Shinde also said that Economics is the most valuable subject in social science stream, students from Economics can get more career opportunities than the other specialization. Dr. Subhash Kombde given speech on 'Career Opportunities in Economics' He told that Economics Graduate students can get opportunities in variety of sectors of the economy easily than the other one. Students having Economics background can crack MPSC, UPSC examination easily, can go to Banking fields as well, they are eligible to teach even Arts, Commerce and even Science faculty students as Professor. Manufacturing as well as service sector also open for students from Economics subject. He also elaborated many more opportunities available for students. 142 students were present for the program and got benefited by the guidance.

But thing is that our students couldn't know these wide range of job opportunities in these areas. This one day free online webinar aims to reach that lacuna and therefore our 'Dr. Shankarraoji Chavan Competitive Examination Guidance Cell conducts this webinar in collaboration with the reputed institution in career guidance sector that is The Unique Academy, Pune.

In his inaugural speech he said that, student should set their goals and should know the thrust areas of their aspirant sectors. Students should find out the hurdles as well as solution to get success in desired areas. Dr. Shinde said that banking is one of the biggest service sectors in the economy and provides wide range of career opportunities to the skilled manpower. Further he said that, there are various types of banks in the economy but each one has different kind of requirements, so needed skilled manpower as per their requirement, which leads to creates many job opportunities to the eligible persons. Along with this student should know about Staff Selection Commission exams which also provide plenty of jobs in various areas. He expected that, this one day free online webinar on "Career Opportunities through Banking PO, IBPS and Staff Selection Commission Exams" might have fulfilling student thrust.

In his presidential speech Dr. Navnath Ghuge congratulated the college Career Guidance Cell to conduct such activities for students even in COVID -19 pandemic situations. During graduation this is the right time to think and act about career opportunities because we have very less family responsibilities as such and has plenty of time spent for studies. But in this regard students must learn to simultaneously adjust their time table of college study and competitive studies.

In this session Ms. Mayuri madam said that there are at least 70000 to 100000 job opportunities are available per year but unfortunately share of Maharashtrian students in success of banking exams seems much less. She told that any graduate from commerce, arts, science, even engineering background can avail banking job opportunity easily. Only in banking sector there are more than 30 types of examination for students. Institute of Banking Personal Selection (IBPS) is the agency which conducts these various types of banking exams. She described that there are several reasons to join banking jobs i.e. job security, good salary, fixed time table, it's for every graduates, same syllabus for Pre examination of IBPS, RRB and SSC, educational leave facility, work life balance possible, scope for individual growth etc. She talked about recruitment process through IBPS exams in detail. Ms. Mayuri madam also explained that, there are five areas to be covered by the students to get success in banking exam i.e. English, Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, General Awareness, Computer Awareness etc. She also explained the eligibility criteria for RBI and Insurance AO post that, there should be at least 60 percent mars are required in graduation level. There is last stage of selection is interview for that Group discussion is took into consideration.

Therefore, lakhs of banking vacancies are awaitingfor skilled graduate students of any discipline and they can apply for the post of clerkship to officer grade in any banks. Students need to prepare for such banking exams (like IBPS, PO, IBPS various grade in various banks like RRB, SBI, RBI, NABARD and other banks) to get placed in one of the reputed banks of the country every year. These all banking exams are conducted at National level throughout the year. Candidates who aspire for banking career must be aware about all the banking exams and start preparing. Bank have very defined exam scheduled. Aspirants who want to end their struggle soon and get respected government job, they opt for banking jobs. Aspirants must update themselves about eligibility criteria, previous year cut offs, exam pattern, syllabus, marking scheme and time to time changes therein. Ms. Mayuri finally said that, with well plan, time management, practice of back question papers any aspirants can obtain these jobs in banking sector. Session end with vote of thank. More than 275 participants got benefited by this session.

Guidance Session II:

Topic: "Career Opportunities through Staff Selection Commission Exams" -

Speaker: Mr. Govind Hibbare, Faculty, The Unique Academy, Pune.

In this session Mr. Hibbare focuses more on the posts recruitment of B and C and D category of central government through Staff Selection Commission (SSC). He explained that to serve 136 crores of peoples needed broadly more than crores of staff which is recruited by SSC. Every year broadly 5 percent peoples gets retired so there are at least 5 lakhs of job opportunities are there through SSC. Therefore students might not neglect this wide range of job opportunities sector. These all post are required very less qualification i.e. 10 class pass, so almost all persons can obtain these opportunities very easily. Posts Assistant Audit Officer, Assistant Section Officer, Junior Statistical Officer, Inspector, Sub Inspector, Divisional Accountant, SSC- CGL, SSC-CPO, SSC- GD Constable, SSC-CHSL, SSC- MTS, SSC-Stenographer, Peon, Mali, Chowkidar, Safaiwala, Daftary etc. are the most important posts recruited through SSC and having good salary too.

He explained about the SSC exam pattern, eligibility criterion, age limit, process to apply, tentative exam schedule etc. Mr. Hibbare sir pointed out that with good awareness and well study plan you may grab wide range of job opportunities through the SSC.
