





Submission of Utilization Certificate under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Mission Guidelines for Utilize Fund and Submission of Utilization Certificate under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Mission

- The Participating Institute is provided Seed Money (Base Level Funding) by the National Coordinating Institute, IIT Delhi at the time of joining Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Mission as one time grants.
- 2. For further more funding, the PIshave to apply through technological proposal (SEG) by PI login under financial aid section of UBA website.

- 3. The PIs can also rise funding through funding convergence from different funding agencies/NGOs/Other sources. The details of funding convergence shall mandatory provide to NCI& RCI at the time of UC submission.
- 4. The village survey form is one for every village and the household survey form is not needed to be uploaded for household survey, the PIs can go for random selection and according to the situation. The household survey forms uploaded should be around 25% of the houses but according to the situation, nearly 25% should cover all the sections of society.
- 5. The survey is required to be completed within 2 months after joining and data is to be uploaded within 3month and if not done please complete within this extension time positively, otherwise UC won't be accepted.
- 6. The grants/Seed Money worth of Rs.50, 000/- (Rs. Fifty thousand only) is only for villages' surveys and repo building with villagers @ Rs. 10,000/- per village.
- 7. The communion/rapport building will contain all the activities such as awareness programs', competitions, camps, Gramsabhas, etc.
- 8. Contingency, Consumables & Travel are the main heads for incurring grants/Seed Money. Stationary, Banner, Logistic are the main areas of utilizing funds.
- 9. The PIs cannot draw salary from this allocated fund but provide honorarium if required only upto certain limit with proper justification.
- 10. The PIs prohibits for creation of any capital assets out the grant/seed money sanction under this scheme. The UC containing any capital assets won't be accepted.
- 11. The Utilization Certificate along with Statement of Expenditure shall submit only in prescribed format enclosed herewith with the seal & signature of head of Institution & Finance Officer (Please See Annexure I & II).




